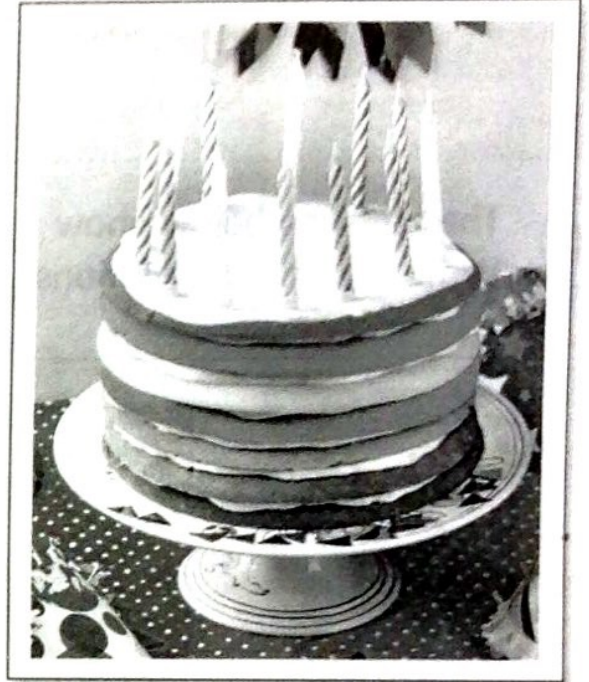


Writing Instructions

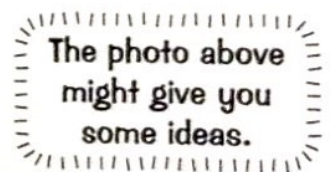
Here are some instructions for making a cake. They are all muddled up. Can you put them in the right order? The first word will give you a big clue. The first word is an imperative verb.

1. Split the cake mix between seven bowls and add a different colour to each one.
2. Put the sugar and butter in a bowl and mix them together.
3. Bake each cake for 15 minutes.
4. Sieve the flour, then add it to the sugar, butter and eggs. Stir gently.
5. Start by weighing out the ingredients.
6. Once the butter and sugar are mixed, add the eggs.
