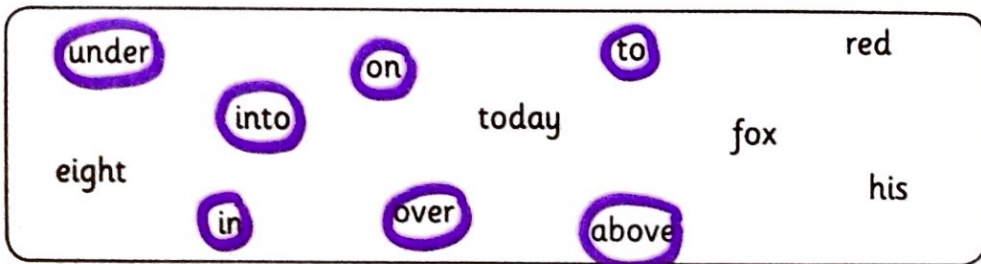


# ANSWERS Prepositions WEDNESDAY

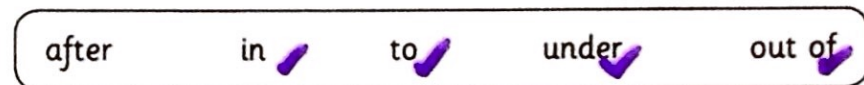
