

<p><b>Looking, Listening &amp; Reading</b> Our class read aloud text will be Percy Jackson and the lightning Thief.</p>  <p>Reading Skills are Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summary.</p>	<p><b>Earth and Space</b> - children will understand the movement of the Earth and the moon, and how they relate to the Solar System. Children will understand the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.</p> 	<p><b>Year 4:</b> Mrs Hammond's group will develop their understanding of place value and learn about numbers to 10,000, rounding and partitioning numbers and learn about Roman numerals. We will practice adding and subtracting 4-digit numbers, estimate answers and use checking strategies. We will learn about area before developing our understanding of times tables. Learning times tables up to 12 x12 is a key part of the Year 4 curriculum and as such we would value your input in helping your child to practise them at home, as well as in school.</p> <p><b>Year 5:</b> Mrs Watkins's group will begin with understanding numbers to 1,000,000. We will learn Roman numerals. We will practice multistep addition and subtraction problems, inverse operations and missing number calculations. We will then move on to factors, primes, squares and cubes and multiplying or dividing by multiples of 10. Finally, we will be recognising equivalent fractions, adding fractions and converting mixed numbers to improper fractions.</p>

<p><b>Invasion Games</b></p> <p>The children will be playing invasion games this term, including netball and lacrosse.</p>  <p>In gymnastics children will be matching and mirroring.</p>


History
<p><b>Ancient Greece</b></p> <p>Children will study the great civilisation of the Ancient Greeks and learn about inventions and innovations, their enemies and allies, their beliefs, myths and everyday life. We will learn how we know about the Greek civilisation, what survives of it and how their ideas still impact enormously on us today.</p> 

Geography
<p><b>Greece and the UK</b></p>  <p>Children will learn about Greece, it's boarding countries and seas, it's physical and human features and compare it to the UK.</p>

French
 <p><b>French</b></p> <p>Children will be recapping greetings, becoming confident to introduce themselves in French. Children will also learn time phrases and recap counting in French.</p>

RE
<p><b>What kind of world did Jesus want? [Gospel]</b></p>  <p>Children will explore the four gospels and what they tell us about the life and teaching of Jesus and they will consider why many Christians get involved in charities and fund raising.</p>

Music
 <p><b>Sing Up Music- Kisse banaaya</b> Kisse banaaya is a song in Hindi from the Indian Classical Tradition.</p> <p>Children will learn how to sing in rounds.</p>  <p><b>Recorder</b> Whole class peripatetic teaching of recorder in Autumn 2.</p>

Art and Design
<p><b>Art- creating Krater vases</b></p>  <p>Children will be making close observation of Krater vases, use shading, colour mixing and decoration to emulate the effects to create their own vases using clay.</p>

Design & Technology
