My Body and Me

We will learn that we are animals alike and begin to sort and compare animals into different groups fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

We will be learning to recognise numbers from 1-5 in great depth. We will learn to count, write and make numbers up to 5 by adding two amounts together. We will also look at repeating patterns and shape in our environment.

History

Children will be able to compare their lives to lives in the past. We will take a closer look at the types of food and packaging that were used in the past compared to now.



Our focus story for this term will Hedgehog be 'Little Wolf's Book of Badness' by Ian Whybrow. This gripping Class book will enable the children to **Autumn Term** delve into traditional tales and develop their vocabulary through 2024 character descriptions. They will Little Wolf's experience what is like to have a mischievous Big Bad Wolf in the **Book of** school and become inspectors to Badness!' help find him. What badness will the wolf get up to?!

Geography



Children will learn to use simple maps to locate the UK and our school and to understand compass points and directions. They will also learn that England is one of the four nations and is part of the continent of Europe.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be learning about keeping ourselves physically and emotionally safe through the topics: Being a good friend and protecting ourselves from bullying, looking after those in need, rules and acts of kindness.



Children will know that Christians believe God made the world, they will understand the story of Creation is found in genesis, in the Old Testament of the Christian Bible.

Later we will look at how Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus on the 25th December each year. It is also a time of celebration for non-christians all over the world. Children will develop their knowkedge of the Christmas story looking at evidence from the gospel.

Music
